

## Important Information for your travel planning to Mount TITLIS in 2026

Dear Partners

The infrastructure on Mount TITLIS is undergoing extensive renewal and modernization until spring 2029. This ambitious project, designed by the renowned Swiss architects Herzog & de Meuron, the creators of iconic landmarks like the “Bird’s Nest” in Beijing and the “Tate Modern” in London, will significantly enhance the guest experience at the highest excursion mountain in Central Switzerland — including its impressive glacier landscape.

To support your travel planning for the 2026 season, we would like to provide you with an overview of key changes and operational adjustments.

### A. TITLIS Tower

The official international opening celebrations will take place on 28 May 2026. The TITLIS Tower will be open to guests from 5 June 2026. The TITLIS Tower has three levels, including a lobby, and can be accessed via the glacier or through the new underground entrance.

#### 1. Horizon Deck – Breathtaking Panoramic Views of the Alps

The new Horizon Deck viewing platform, at a height of 70 metres, offers an impressive 360-degree, three-country panoramic view of the Alpine landscape. It is almost impossible to go any higher.

- Direct access from the TITLIS Tower lobby via elevator
- Separate tickets required for individual guests and groups

#### 2. Joseph’s Restaurant – Casual Fine Dining at 3’000 metres

Sophisticated dining at lofty heights with spectacular views. One floor below the Horizon Deck is the new Joseph’s Restaurant, named after the pioneer who was the first to climb Mount TITLIS on skis in 1904. We offer casual fine dining with creations by world-renowned Michelin-starred chef Dietmar Sawyere.

- Total seating capacity: 120 guests (lounge area: 60 guests and restaurant: 60 guests)
- Advance reservations for restaurant and lounge are recommended

#### 3. Rolex Boutique

Directly below Joseph’s Restaurant is the new home to the world’s highest Rolex boutique in the TITLIS Tower. Your guests will be immersed in an exclusive world of experiences with a magnificent backdrop.

### B. Guest flow & access on Mount TITLIS

Following the opening of the TITLIS Tower, work will begin on the new peak station, which will also be designed by Herzog & de Meuron. We will endeavour to carry out the construction work in a way that it does not inconvenience your guests’ summit experience. From June 2026 onwards, the current building will no longer be accessible to guests.

Please note the following:

- Our main attractions, the Cliff Walk, Glacier Cave, Ice Flyer and Glacier Park, will remain open to guests during this time.
- Access to the new TITLIS Tower will be possible from 5 June 2026 onwards. Guests can access it via the new Rock Passage tunnel, located next to the Glacier Cave, or via the outdoor snow path.
- The access route to the outdoor glacier follows the south-west bypass, which forms part of the new mountain station's future facade. This area offers guests an impressive insight into the future TITLIS experience and a view of Europe's highest construction site.
- Right on the glacier, the temporary facility 'High Base' on Mount TITLIS will provide toilets and a limited selection of food and drinks.
- During the construction phase, facilities for wheelchair users will be limited. In exceptional cases, our staff will provide personal assistance. Advance notice for wheelchairs and pushchairs is recommended.

## C. Trübsee

From spring 2026 onwards, the gastronomy and retail offerings will gradually be relocated from the TITLIS Peak Station to the Trübsee middle station at 1'800 metres, creating an attractive and convenient base for all guests.

### **Group restaurants**

- Not available from January 2026 until spring 2029.
- The Cliff Walk and Ice Flyer cameras will continue to operate as usual.

## D. TITLIS Connect

From spring 2026, guests will be able to enjoy the new TITLIS Connect cable car, which will transport them in style on one of the glacier's most modern gondolas. This will enable us to remain open all year round.

- TITLIS Connect offers panoramic views and operates along the same route as the TITLIS Rotair between Stand and the mountain station.
- It is a single-track, non-rotating cable car with one cabin that can hold 75 people per ride.
- During the annual TITLIS Rotair maintenance period, access to Mount TITLIS will be via the TITLIS Connect cable car.

## E. TITLIS Rotair – Special maintenance

As part of the redesign of the peak station, the TITLIS Rotair cables will be re-hung, and essential safety work will be carried out. This work will ensure that the TITLIS Rotair, like the new building itself, is fit for the future.

The TITLIS Rotair will be closed from 10 August to 11 December 2026. During this period, visitors can reach the TITLIS summit with the new TITLIS Connect cable car.
