

Summer Season at TITLIS:

Essential Information for Tour Operators

Here is all the important information you need to know for planning a trip to Mount TITLIS this summer/autumn.

A. Maintenance of TITLIS Rotair – TITLIS remains open

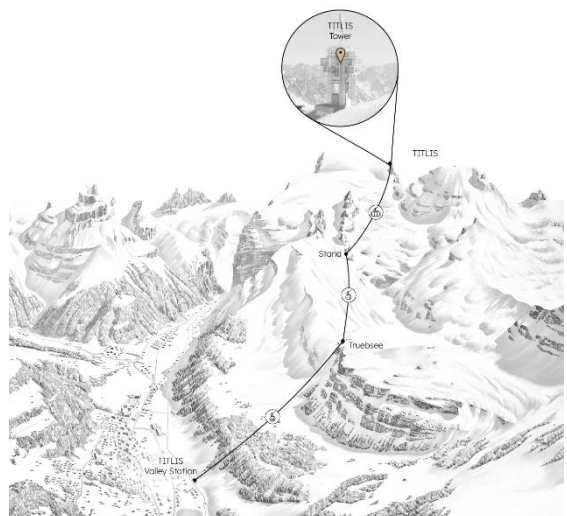


TITLIS Rotair will be closed for maintenance from 17 August until 11 December 2026. However, the TITLIS summit and all glacier activities remain fully accessible. Guests will be transported via the new TITLIS Connect cable car during this time.

The route to TITLIS will look as follows: Engelberg - Truebsee - Stand – TITLIS

To ensure a smooth and pleasant journey, a waiting area has been set up at Truebsee, featuring various activities, shops, and restaurants for you to enjoy. We anticipate higher visitor numbers between 10:30 am and 12:30 pm. For the best experience, we recommend arriving at the valley station either early in the morning or after this peak period.

For support, you can approach our Mountain Hosts, wearing yellow vests, who will support you on your journey.

B. New Highlight: TITLIS Tower



The TITLIS Tower is the new landmark at over 3000 meters above sea level. What once was a communication tower has been transformed into an architectural masterpiece that redefines the summit. Discover the Horizon Deck, a spectacular viewing platform high above the glacier, experience casual fine dining with panoramic views at Joseph's Restaurant, and visit the exclusive Rolex Boutique. Here, pioneering spirit and architecture designed by Herzog & de Meuron meet the majestic beauty of the high Alps. The TITLIS Tower reveals a whole new perspective on the summit—a place created to be seen, experienced, and remembered.

C. Summer activities on the Glacier

The historic peak station is currently undergoing a complete transformation, set for completion by spring 2029. Throughout the construction, glacier access and all activities remain fully available to our guests. Additionally, the new Rock Passage tunnel next to the Glacier Cave now seamlessly connects the TITLIS Tower and the Cliff Walk.

Please note: Due to the ongoing construction, this area is currently not wheelchair accessible.

During this period, a selection of drinks, snacks, and restrooms can be found at the new High Base structure, located just outside the peak station. For a full dining experience, the group restaurant NomNom and various souvenir shops are welcoming guests at the Truebsee middle station.

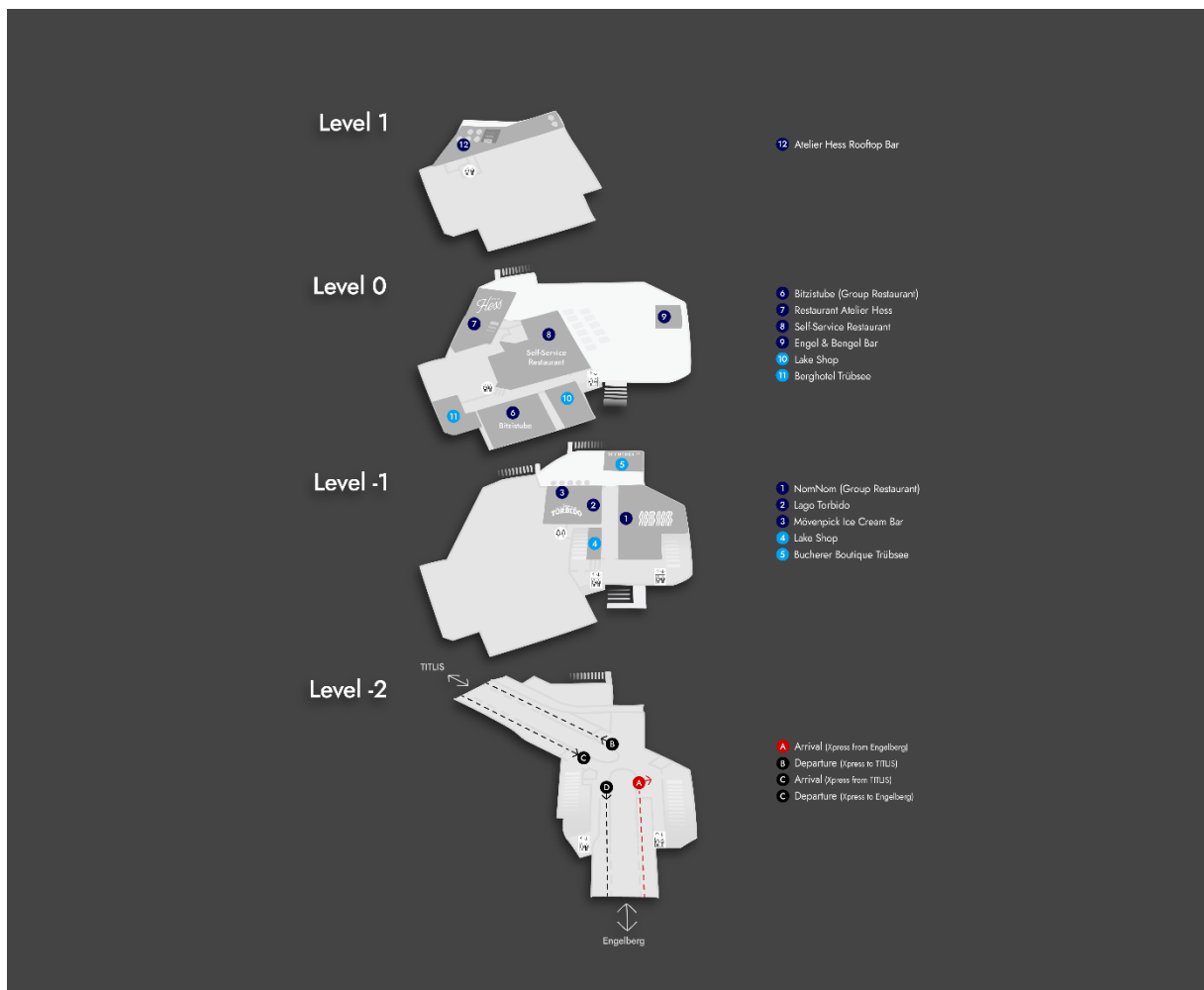

F. TITLIS Project

With the opening of the TITLIS Tower, the first major milestone of the TITLIS project has been reached. At over 3,000 meters above sea level, the new architectural landmark has taken shape, designed by the renowned architecture firm Herzog & de Meuron. Set amid snow, rock, and glacier, the TITLIS Tower opens up new perspectives on the mountain world and marks a new chapter in alpine architecture.

At the same time, the next important phase of the project is beginning: the transformation of the existing mountain station into the new TITLIS Peak Station, scheduled to open in 2029. This means the TITLIS project remains one of Europe's highest-altitude mountain construction sites and a milestone of modern architecture under some of the most demanding conditions.

Good to know: During the construction period, temporary changes to visitor routes may still occur. At times, there may also be construction noise, and rock material from the works may be visible on the snow. Temporary facilities will also remain in place near the Truebsee Alpine Lodge as part of the project. All attractions remain open as usual, and the panorama is as breathtaking as ever. Should there be any future changes, we will keep you informed in good time.
